### **Notice of Race**

#### **1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY**

The Organising Authority (OA) is Foynes Yacht Club (FYC).

#### **2. RULES**

2.1 The series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2.2 The prescriptions of the I.S.A. will apply.

#### **3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

3.1 General. Eligible boats may be entered by completing the registration form issued by Foynes Yacht Club and on payment of the appropriate fees. Entry fee payable at registration is €40 for single handed and €50 double handed. There is a 25% discount for Foynes Yacht Club members.

3.2 Registration. The entry form will be available at Foynes yacht club on 4<sup>th</sup> November

3.3 Entry Fee. Event Entry: Single handed €40

Double handed €50

#### **4. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

4.1 Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk – see RRS 4 – Decision to Race. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event. Foynes Yacht Club, including its officers, employees and agents, the race management team, the support boats and anyone helping to run the event shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death

or personal injury however caused to the owner/competitor or crew as a result of their taking part in the event.

## **5. INSURANCE:**

Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate, valid, third party liability insurance cover inclusive of a racing risks extension.

## **6. SCHEDULE**

6.1 It is proposed to sail 8 races.

## **8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

8.1 The sailing instructions will be available from the club notice board and club website

## **9 THE COURSES**

9.1 The courses to be sailed will be as listed on the briefing board prior to race each morning which is located at the shed

## **10 VENUE**

10.1 The venue will be Foynes Yacht Club.

10.2 Club facilities include free shower and changing facilities, secure trailer storage during the event.

## **11 SCORING**

11.1 The Low Points Scoring System of Appendix A shall apply.

11.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.3 When four or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race score excluding her worst score.

11.4 If 8 races are completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her 2 worst scores.

11.5 A boat that did not finish, retired or was disqualified shall be scored for the finishing place one more than the number of boats starting that race except that a boat that did not start or did not come to the starting area shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of the boats entered in the series.

## **12 PRIZES**

12.1 Prizes will be awarded in the following categories. Categories will be determined after registration closes on the first day of racing. Prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> of each category.
